House Bill 859: Gives you the right to request confidentiality

House Bill 859 gives you the right to ask that a government owned utility not release your personal information to outside parties:

The Open Records Act required that DeSoto Utility Billing Department make our residential customers' personal information (address, telephone number and social security number) available to anyone who asks for it. That law is still in effect. But House Bill 859 now allows DeSoto Utility Billing Department to protect your confidentiality, if you ask us to do so.

We are still required to give personal information to certain organizations and people: other utilities; consumer reporting agencies; state and government officials; contractors or subcontractors working for DeSoto Water Department or another governmental agency; and persons to whom a customer has contractually waived confidentiality.

If you don't want us to release your personal information to telemarketing companies, direct mail advertisers, etc. then fill out the attached form and enclose it with your next water bill.

This law became effective on September 1, 1993.
